ENHANCING YOUR ENVIRONMENT

Aeration

Aeration is one of the most important things you can do to your turf areas. By opening up your soil, you can realize savings through water, fertilizer, and soil amendments. The micronutrient content can be raised by allowing the air in as well.

This time of year to have this done is just before the Bermuda lawns come in. Have your aeration scheduled now and you will be rewarded with a much better looking lawn throughout the year.



Bermuda Grass

Soon the Bermuda Grass will grow through the winter Rye. During this transition, you may notice the consistency and color changes in different areas of your turf. We will begin to adjust mower height lower to help with the transition.

For the Bermuda to begin an active growth cycle, the soil temperature at a depth of 4 inches must consistently be above 65 degrees. Until that time, there may be minimal growth but not something you would call a lawn. Mid May is when we typically expect to see the Bermuda lawns growing.

If you have areas with shade, Bermuda will perform poorly if it grows at all. Six hours of sunlight is the minimum for a good healthy Bermuda lawn. Thinning the trees will help, however they must be trimmed every year to maintain the consistent sunlight. Those same trees will also rob the nutrients and water that the turf needs for good strong growth. These areas make for a very challenging environment where other landscape options may need to be explored.

Finally Some Rain!

Now that we have had some rain, here come the weeds. If you have pre-emergent sprayed on your granite areas, this will help minimize the amount of weeds that are germinated. The weeds can grow at an amazing rate. Sometimes as much as 1-2 feet in as little as 1 week. By that time it is too late to spray them.

Our crews are already fighting weeds in some areas. Most of the summer preparations for summer have been made so we are devoting the man power to weeds.

If you have not yet been sprayed for pre-emergent, contact us to be scheduled as we are as much as 3-4 weeks out getting this on the schedule.

Snake Season

Now that it is warming up, the snakes are looking for food. Make sure you take proper measures when you are walking around. Keep the poison control number available and remember that if you are bitten, immobilize the limb and get immediate medical attention.
