Olive Trees

Time to schedule Olive Tree Spraying!

If you would like to nip it in the bud (pun intended,) we can spray as early as 2-3 months before bloom to right before bloom. The tight bud stage is the best time to treat. "Maintain", a plant growth regulator, is a one-time treatment to the foliage. We can start spraying as early as Jan. 1 until the first part of March, but it is best if sprayed under 85 degrees.

But wait! What if a property didn't ask for the treatment until after it is blooming? We do have more options but if the fruit has developed (flowers dropping, small fruit visible) it is too late. We can spray olive trees when in full bloom and still see about 75% control, but two applications may be needed, and some fruit may still be present for the rest of the season. It is best to plan to spray your olive trees well before blooming.

Take home message: Schedule applications soon to prevent the springtime panic!!

Now that the weather has truly turned cold (well, for those of us that have acclimated to Arizona temperatures!) we will begin to work on those details that may have taken a back seat during the summer growing season. We are finishing up cutting the Bird of Paradise down to the ground, the Lantana will begin to be cut back in some areas where there is other plant life to show color.

For those of you with winter lawns, the water has been cut back and most have been fertilized to help the grass retain its green color with the colder temperatures and less sunlight. Some areas that did not come in with the first distribution of seed are getting more seed and also mulch to help keep those areas wet and warm to help germinate the seed.

Now that budgets have been approved for 2007, you should start thinking about getting your proposals for those projects you plan on doing this winter and spring. We are still a few weeks out before we can get to approved projects so book them early!
