This month in Landscaping

Next month, February, is the month to spray the Olive Trees that are not the "fruitless" variety. The most effective process is to have them professionally pruned as soon as possible and then sprayed in February. There is a very small window of time to get them sprayed, so a January approval is needed to let us know to get you scheduled.

Additionally, beginning in January and continuing into March, we will be treating the granite areas with a Pre-emergent. Depending on the type of weeds experienced in the past, the chemical used will vary.

Pre-emergent is the process of laying down a chemical barrier that helps to prevent weed germination. While not 100% effective, the difference between treated and untreated is significant. This is especially true in outlying areas that are exposed to disturbed earth and dust which blows weed seed onto your property. Some weeds unaffected by standard Pre-emergent tend to be in the Thistle family, i.e. Star Thistle and Russian Thistle (Tumbleweed).

January we will continue cutting back plants such as the Mexican Bird of Paradise that look bad during the winter and grow back once the temperatures start back up.
