## This month in Landscaping

May flowers are here! Well, due to the late winter rains, April flowers were beautiful. With warmer weather ahead, our summer preparations have paid off.

As you know, the heat of the summer slows work progress, equipment takes a beating, and plants, trees, and grass grow very fast with more hours of sunlight every day.

To move forward, we will be planting those summer annual flowers this month. The winter flowers are just about played out.

Fertilization has already begun. Our first application will be Ammonia Sulfate 21-0-0. The other fertilizations throughout the summer are based on your soil and turf conditions. We will be using deep watering to encourage deep root growth from your Bermuda Grass, Shrubs, and Trees. This will save water in the long run. At some point, irrigation to the trees can be capped off because the roots have found water many feet away from the trunk or further.

If you can get your signed contracts in for aeration, now is the time. We have already begun the turf areas that did not have Winter Rye.

Now is also the time to begin converting turf areas to Xeriscape as a part of long term water conservation program.
