This month in Landscaping

By now if you have requested your winter lawn, your Bermuda should be scalped down low and some of you may have been seeded. If you have been seeded, please remember that Winter Rye grass is one seed, one blade of grass. Please stay off the seeded areas as much as possible until it has been mowed for the first time. This could be several weeks. As a reminder, water will come on several times a day for shorter bursts than normal and the grass will become pretty tall before we can mow it for the first time.

In mid to late October, winter flowers will be installed. You may be without color for 1-2 weeks depending on the soil. The soil should be turned and amendments added before replanting.
